This six week online course will provide students with a practical understanding of gambling and problem gambling. Students will gain efficient tools and confidence to better identify and assist clients who are experiencing a problem with gambling. What will you learn?

At the end of this course, you will be able to do the following:

- describe the fundamental concepts of gambling;
- describe the gambling environment in your province;
- know how to screen clients for problem gambling behaviour;
- know the impact that problem gambling has on family members;
- describe strategies that will prompt your clients to explore their gambling behaviour and seek help if needed; and
- know the community supports and services that are available to people with gambling problems in your province.
